## Modernizing Warren's Wastewater Future

We knew this upgrade was coming — and we planned ahead. The City of Warren is moving forward with a state-of-the-art solids dewatering and incineration facility to replace the original system built in 1972. This investment will keep our wastewater system safe, efficient, and ready for the future.

### Key Wins for Warren:

**Cutting-Edge Technology:** We're replacing outdated equipment with the latest treatment and incineration technology — improving performance and reducing air pollution.

**Secured Smart Funding:** We locked in low-interest financing through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, saving taxpayers millions over the life of the project.

**Grant Relief for Residents:** More than \$9.2 million in principal loan forgiveness will directly reduce project costs for Warren residents.

**Cleaner, More Efficient Operations:** The new system will significantly lower emissions, reduce utility costs, and improve sludge treatment efficiency.

### Project Details:

**Location:** Within the existing Wastewater Treatment Plant

**Construction Start:** January 2026

**Estimated Completion:** Up to 3 years

**Total Investment:** \$110.3 million






