

CITY OF WARREN: NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR MICHIGAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG-DISASTER RECOVERY) FUNDING FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Warren will conduct a public hearing at City Council's regularly-scheduled April 28, 2026 meeting, located in the Warren Community Center auditorium at 7:00 p.m. EDT, to afford citizens an opportunity to submit comments on the proposed application for a CDBG-Disaster Recovery grant.

The City of Warren proposes two (2) requests: a priority request of \$4,370,000 in CDBG-DR funds to oversee the construction and installation of a relief sewer system in Section 2 of the City (13 to 14 Mile/ Hoover to Schoenherr), and a secondary request of approx. \$4,058,711 in CDBG-DR funds to oversee the full replacement of existing watermain, sanitary main, and storm sewer systems on Rivard and Jackson Avenues, specifically between Van Dyke Avenue and Mac Arthur Boulevard.
