

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

This letter is a NOTICE HEREBY GIVEN to you that a public hearing has been scheduled and will be held by the City Council for the City of Warren in connection with the following petition to rezone land in your neighborhood:

Five parcels of land in the City of Warren Macomb County, Michigan, Parcel Identification Numbers 13-33-201-010 (22930 Sherwood), 13-33-201-011 (6725 Dodge), 13-33-201-013 (6729 Dodge), 13-33-201-012 (6731 Dodge) and 13-33-201-014 (6745 Dodge) more particularly described as:

13-33-201-010: Lots 33 through 37, both inclusive, including the adjacent west ½ of vacated alley along the east line of Liberty Park Subdivision according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Liber 9 of Plats, Page 36, Macomb County Records.

13-33-201-011: Lot 38 including the adjacent easterly ½ of vacated alley along the west line and southerly ½ of vacated alley along the north line, of Liberty Park Subdivision according to the Plat thereof as recorded Liber 9 of Plats, Page 36, Macomb County Records.

13-33-201-012: Lot 39 including the adjacent southerly ½ of vacated alley along the north line, of Liberty Park Subdivision according to the Plat thereof as recorded Liber 9 of Plats, Page 36, Macomb County Records.

13-33-201-013: Lot 40 including the adjacent southerly ½ of vacated alley the north line, of Liberty Park Subdivision according to the Plat thereof as recorded Liber 9 of Plats, Page 36, Macomb County Records.

13-33-201-014: Lots 41 and 42, of Liberty Park Subdivision according the Plat thereof as recorded in Liber 9 of Plats, Page 36, Macomb County Records.

be rezoned from its present zoning “R-1-P”, One-Family Residential and Parking District and M-2, Medium Light Industrial District to “M-1”, Light Industrial District.

The public hearing will be held **Tuesday, January 14, 2020**, in the City Council Chambers of the Warren Community Center Auditorium, 5460 Arden, located west of Mound between Chicago and Fourteen Mile Roads. The City Council meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide the petitioner with an opportunity to represent his interests and to give you an opportunity to voice your opinion or ask any questions concerning this request.
