Helpful Hints For Training Your Pet

Most people believe cats cannot be trained, but the first scientific studies of the importance of reinforcement in animal behavior was done with cats. Here are a few tips: Training a cat requires creativity and patience, so it is important to know your cat and what motivates them (treats, food, and toys). Using a "clicker" can make training faster and easier. The instant your cat does the correct behavior, click and give a treat. Do not use punishment. Positive reinforcement works much better. Even if your cat does not learn to sit on command every time, the training is a great way to bond with your cat.
