NOTICE OF PUBLIC APPEAL HEARING

Notification is hereby being provided that the Hearing Officer for the City of Warren has determined that a dangerous condition exists in violation of the Code of Ordinances and has ordered abatement of such condition on the described property. A formal notice has been posted on the property itself.

The property is described as:

Legal Description: 23090 Stewart – (13-25-476-022), Lot 245, SUPERVISOR’S CHESTERFIELD PARK SUBDIVISION NO. 2, as recorded in Liber 17, page 38 of Plats, Macomb County Records.

Condition: Dilapidated one story house (997 sq. ft.) with crawl and possible slab foundation. Remove two dead trees marked, remove side gate and damaged 4 ft. chain link fence.

In order to provide an appeal from the decision and order of the Hearing Officer, the City Council has scheduled a public appeal hearing.

The public hearing will be held **Tuesday, July 28, 2020**, at 7:00 pm Via Zoom Video Conferencing, pursuant under executive order 2020-48 issued by Governor Gretchen Whitmer, of the State of Michigan on April 14, 2020. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide the petitioner with an opportunity to represent his interests and to give you an opportunity to voice your opinion or ask any questions concerning this request.
