INVASIVE SPECIES TREATMENT NOTICE

The Lake St. Clair Cooperative Invasive Species Management Area (LSC CISMA) in conjunction with the Drainage Board for the Red Run Intercounty Drain comprising of the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner's office and the Macomb County Public Works Office hereby provides notice to the public and property owners for the control of invasive plant species Giant knotweed (*Polygonum sachalinensis*) (*Fallopia sachalinensis*) and Japanese knotweed (*Fallopia japonica*). Schedule & Treatment Locations:

- Weather permitting, applications will take place September 21 - October 15, 2020
- Treatments will take place within sections of Macomb County Red Run Drain easement in Warren and Sterling Heights.

Herbicide, Methods of Application & Re-Entry Restrictions:

- Clearcast (Imazamox), Rodeo (glyphosate), Elite Splendor (dye) and Cygnet Plus (drift control, surfactant).
- All applications will be foliar, applied by backpack sprayer. The herbicide will be tank mixed.
- **Do not enter treated areas until the spray has dried.**
