Warren City Hall Lights Up Tonight For Pitt-Hopkins Syndrome

Warren, MI – Warren City Hall will feature light blue lights tonight from dusk until dawn to bring public attention to Pitts-Hopkins syndrome.

Pitt-Hopkins syndrome is a condition characterized by intellectual disability and developmental delay, breathing problems, recurrent seizures (epilepsy), and distinctive facial features.

Approximately 750 Pitt-Hopkins syndrome patients have been identified worldwide, but there are many who remain undiagnosed. A Warren resident reached out to Mayor Fouts about this condition, her child was diagnosed with Pitt-Hopkins Syndrome. Mayor Fouts issued a proclamation and has directed that city hall be lit up to bring awareness.
