

ALL MEDIA FOR IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION - CITY OF WARREN - MAYOR FOUTS DECLARES SNOW EMERGENCY IN WARREN

Good afternoon,

I'm officially declaring a snow emergency for Warren at 3PM today. Cars can expect to be ticketed after 5PM. The bulk of the heavy snow will be during rush hour. Expectations are for up to an additional snow fall of nearly seven inches. DPW will dispatch 12 trucks for the mains and 1/2 miles. There will be 2 teams of 5 trucks round the clock for residential streets. Each team will do a section. They will not be able to begin until after rush hour at about 8PM. It's also predicted that the snow will conclude by 8 as well. It is estimated that the entire operation will take about 30 hours. The priority order of snow removal will be the following:

1)Main roads 2)1/2 miles 3)Bus routes 4)Neighborhood streets and the order of the streets will be based upon garbage routes.

Note: I also ordered zone and pick up trucks with plows to go into the cul-de-sac and into the dead end streets. Please try to help those in need move their vehicles off the street so that the DPW trucks can do their job! Thanks!
