

The City of Warren seeks comments on the 2017 Justice Assistance Grant

Based on local needs and conditions, the Warren Police Department, Macomb County Community Corrections, the Macomb County Sheriff's Office are applying for a United States Department of Justice JAG grant that designed to aid substance abuse offenders, combat crime, and enhance officer safety.

The money from the grant will go to aid several law enforcement projects including support for offenders with substance abuse issues through the Macomb County Community Corrections jail diversion program; the Sheriff's Office will add new computers along with audio/video redacting software to support their Body Worn Camera policy; the Warren Police Department will use the funds to enhance officer and citizen safety with the addition of an Unmanned Aerial System.

The public is invited to review the Memorandum of Understanding and the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program – FY 2017, Local Solicitation application and to make comments.
