Mayor Fouts, Chief City Attorney, Warren Police and Fire To Address Lincoln High and Middle School Students on Active Shooter Topic April 20 at 9 a.m.

Warren, MI – Warren Mayor Jim Fouts, Chief Assistant City Attorney Mary Michaels, Warren Police Commissioner Bill Dwyer and Warren Fire Commissioner Skip McAdams will address Lincoln High and Middle School students on active school shooters Friday, April 20 at 9 a.m. in the Van Dyke Community Auditorium off Federal Avenue located at Lincoln High School.

“This is part of the police-school partnership to prevent school shootings,” said Fouts. It is the next step we are taking after our initial meeting with school leaders.”

Mayor Fouts and Warren police met with 51 school leaders on Thursday, March 1 to discuss school shooter strategies.
