Blight Busters!

Warren Neighborhood Clean Sweep Program Begins Its 10th Year – April 23

Warren, MI – Warren’s Neighborhood Clean Sweep Program begins its tenth year as blight inspectors are going street-by-street starting April 23.

Warren Mayor Jim Fouts initiated the program in 2008 after he was elected in 2007. “This program is part of my campaign commitment to create a cleaner city,” said Fouts. “It is a neighborhood-by-neighborhood, street-by-street, house-by-house cleanup.”

Since Neighborhood Clean Sweep Program began, blight inspectors have inspected over 150,000 residential and commercial properties, handing out almost 15,000 warning notices and about 1,800 blight tickets. A vast majority of residents and businesses comply after they are warned.

This program has received attention from state-wide and national publications.
