SECOND DOSE REMINDER

Many of the COVID-19 vaccines are two-dose vaccines. When making the appointment for your first vaccine, check to confirm the recommended timing for the second dose to make sure you are available when your second dose is due.

V-SAFE

Get v-safe – a smartphone-based tool that uses text messaging and surveys to provide personalized health check-ins after you receive a COVID-19 vaccination. V-safe will also remind you to get your second dose if you need one. For more information visit vsafe.cdc.gov.
