

DTE Issues Warren \$46,018 Check For City's LED Streetlight Conversions

Warren, MI – DTE has issued a check to the city of Warren for \$46,018 for the first phase of the city's LED streetlight conversion.

An enlarged copy of the DTE check will be presented to Mayor Jim Fouts by Ron Chriss, DTE regional manager, today at 10:30 a.m. in the Mayor's Office.

"LED streetlights are maintenance-free, energy efficient and brighter making our neighborhoods safer," said Mayor Jim Fouts.

DTE partnered with the city to convert the city's remaining 6,329 mercury vapor streetlights to LED.

The city invested \$1,972,783 in the conversion project but with rebates from DTE, the State of Michigan Energy Office and energy savings, the city saves \$496,672 or \$5,865,731 over the next 15 years.
