**1. Pitcher protection rule:**

**MIDDLE NO HIT ZONE RULE... Any batted ball hit over the mound and below the pitchers head, the ball is dead and an automatic out is declared. It does not matter where the pitcher is located on the field. Base runners must return to the original base. ANY BALL HIT WITHIN THE WIDTH OF THE PITCHING RUBBER (24") FROM GROUND LEVEL TO THE TOP OF PITCHERS HEAD SHALL BE A DEAD BALL OUT.**

A pitcher screen can be used. If a team decides to use a screen they must use it for the entire game. If a batted ball hits the screen it is a dead ball automatic out.

- 2. Home Run Rule. Men's Recreational Division** is limited to three (3) over the fence home runs.  
 Progressive Homerun Rule: All leagues will play with a progressive home run (over the fence) rule.

Either team may go one (1) homerun up as long as the other team has hit the allowed number of home runs. The home team may not go one up in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning or later if both teams have hit their limit. Any homerun hit over the limit will result in an out.

**3. The Strike Zone Mat measuring 2 feet by 3 feet will be used. If a legal pitch hits any part of the mat it will be considered a strike.**

**4. Scoring Line will be used in all games to prevent contact at home plate.** Scoring Line: A 10-foot scoring line shall extend 2 feet from the corner of home plate closest to third base into foul territory at a ninety-degree angle to the third base foul line. A foot down on or beyond the scoring line shall be the same as a foot down on home plate for the purposes of scoring a run. Running outside the end of the scoring line shall be the same as NOT touching home plate. A runner not reaching the scoring line shall be called out if: A defensive player in possession of the ball touches home plate only. A defensive player can not tag the runner when there is a play at home plate.

Commitment Line: A commitment line shall be marked perpendicular to the foul line halfway between third base and home plate. Once a runner's foot touches the ground on or past this line the runner may not return to third base. The base runners must continue on toward the scoring line. Violation will result in an out.

5. **ALCOHOL:** Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all City Parks. No exceptions. City of Warren Ordinance Sec. 23-17 Possession of alcoholic liquors. No person shall bring into, possess or consume alcoholic liquors in a city park. The City of Warren Parks & Recreation Department does not allow the consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages in any city park or at any baseball or softball games. Please refrain from bringing any alcoholic beverage to you softball games. Any person or team bringing alcoholic beverages to the game will be asked to remove the alcohol from the park. If the person and or team does not remove the alcoholic beverages from the park, the game will be forfeited. This rule will be strictly enforced the park supervisor and the umpire. The supervisor and umpire have the authority not to continue a game or forfeit the game if the alcohol has not been removed from the park. Any player found playing intoxicated shall be ejected from the game and suspended for a minimum of one game.

6. The Home Team is posted on the right-hand side of the schedule. (Teams will Alternate Home Team Status for the second game.)

7. **RAIN-OUT NUMBER:** (586) 268-1055 – WILL BE ACTIVATED BETWEEN 3:30 AND 4:00 PM.

8. Roster must be submitted to the Warren Parks and Recreation Department no later than the first game scheduled. Those teams not turning in their roster by the deadline could result in a forfeit all games played until the contracts are submitted.
