



Microenterprise Assistance Grant Program

The Microenterprise Assistance Grant Program will make up to \$475,000 available to help local businesses impacted by COVID-19. To qualify as a microenterprise you must be a brick and mortar business that has five (5) or fewer employees, one or more who owns the enterprise at the time of receiving assistance, and the owner(s) must have an annual household income at or below 80% Area Median Income (AMI).

**Applications will be accepted
April 5 - May 19, 2021**

Who is eligible?

- Brick and mortar business in the City of Warren
- A business that has been in operation for at least one year
- Employ no more than 5 employees (including the owners) AND the owner's household income may not exceed 80% AMI based on household size
- Business must be able to verify that they have been negatively impacted by COVID-19
- Must be a for-profit organization
- Business must have a valid Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Business must have registered in the System for Award Management
- Business must showcase a verifiable need for working capital to support payroll, rent, mortgage payments, utility expenses, and/or other expenses that occur in the ordinary course of business
