

# Is Your Home Lead Safe?

**Many homes in Warren contain lead hazards that put children at risk. The City of Warren provides grants for the repairs needed to ensure your home is safe and lead-free.**

If you meet all of the requirements listed below, you may qualify for the City's program.

**Location:** The home to be repaired must be located in the City of Warren.

**Age of Home:** The house must have been built before 1978 and have lead-based paint hazards.

**Income:** The income for all persons residing in the home must be below 80% of area median income. See income limits below:

| Household Size | Maximum Household Income | Household Size | Maximum Household Income |

| 1              | \$44,800                 | 5              | \$69,150                 |
| 2              | \$51,200                 | 6              | \$74,250                 |

| 4              | \$64,000                 | 8              | \$84,500                 |

**Children:** There must be a resident child 0-5 years of age who lives in the home. Children in regular daycare and pregnant women are included.

Homes occupied by children with known elevated blood lead levels will be given priority.

Your home may also be eligible for additional free repairs for health and safety items based on a full-healthy home assessment.
