

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION **Lyons Circle W. Pavement Replacement**

As part of Mayor Fouts' commitment to maintaining and improving the City of Warren's infrastructure, Lyons Circle W from Buchanan to Pagels will be reconstructed. Zuniga Cement Construction, Inc. has been awarded the contract for this work. This project is primarily funded with the Local Street Road Repairs Millage approved in 2011.

The project is scheduled to begin on or around June 6, 2022 and is expected to be completed by October 28, 2022, weather permitting.

The scope of the project is to install new concrete pavement along Lyons Circle W. and edge drain installation. This also includes removing and replacing drive approaches, sidewalks, and ramps as necessary. During the duration of this project, traffic will be closed in two stages. Signs will be posted.

Drive approaches will be replaced only to the extent necessary to facilitate the road construction. The limits of a drive approach replacement may vary. During the construction, residents can expect temporary driveway and sidewalk closures as work progresses. These types of closures will be coordinated in advance with the property owners and the field staff assigned to the project. If needed, parking will be available on the adjacent roads – Buchanan and Pagels.

Generally, construction work hours will be 7:00 AM until 7:30 PM Monday thru Friday and occasionally 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM on Saturday. Work hours may also be extended if work falls behind schedule due to weather conditions or other unforeseen conditions.

Please continue to place garbage, compost and recycling containers curbside as normal. It is recommended that property owners place their address on garbage or recycling containers. Mail service to your property will be uninterrupted during construction.
