PROPERTY MAINTENANCE NEWS

Your Garbage, Recycle and Compost carts are to be taken off the curb no later than 12 hours after sanitation has picked up. Your carts are to be stored on the side of your house or in your backyard, not in the front of your home.

City Snow Removal Policy

Warren city ordinance requires that all property owners remove snow from their sidewalks 12 hours after the snow stops. This applies to all property owners, residential, commercial and industrial. Where there is no sidewalk, the occupant or owner shall clear a path free from snow and ice where sidewalks would otherwise be to facilitate pedestrian use.
