Resource Advocacy Program assists Macomb County seniors, 60 years and older. Resource advocates assess each individual's needs and make referrals to appropriate resources in the community. Each of the programs available through Resource Advocacy has different eligibility requirements. Assistance is also available for those who are homebound. These services include assistance with Medicare Part D enrollment, Medicaid, Tax Credit, Food Stamps, etc.

Title V, Senior Community Service

Employment Program provides part-time work (average 19 hours per week) and job training in community service agencies for those who qualify (low income and 55 years of age and older). Senior Fraud Prevention

- NEVER let anyone in your house.
- Always ask for photo identification. Any legitimate person will not be offended and will freely display it.
- On the telephone, do not give personal information to anyone.
- Never go out of your house with them so they can show you what needs to be fixed. While you are outside with one, another con artist is inside cleaning you out.
- Don't feel pressured into signing any work order or contract quickly. A genuine good deal will still be there tomorrow. If you believe that you may have become a victim, notify the police immediately and file a report. If you are suspicious of a person who is at your house, call 911 immediately.
