Home Repair Loans Available

The City of Warren's Residential Rehabilitation Program is accepting applications from income-eligible households for low or no interest loans. The loans are used to bring the home up to code and make repairs to owner-occupied single-family residences. The maximum loan amount is \$30,000. To qualify for the Program, applicants must **own** and **occupy** the home, have homeowner's insurance, have a history of making house and property tax payments (including the water bill) on time, and have a household income that is below the limits established by The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

The Citizen of the Month, each month, will be announced in the monthly Water Bill insert, on Social Media, TV Warren, and on the City's website.





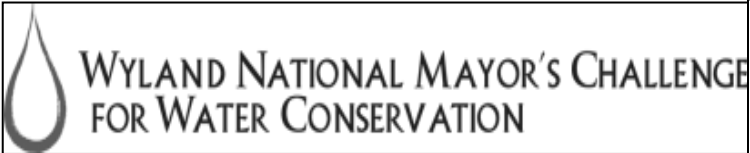

TAKE BACK PRESCRIPTION DRUGS DAY LOCATIONS

Sat., Apr. 22 – 10 am – 2 pm

Locations: Warren Police Department - *Both locations* (permanent dropbox inside the building)
Also, Centerline Police Department, 7070 E. 10 Mile Road (west of Van Dyke).

Pills should be out of the prescription bottle and in a plastic bag. No liquids or needles.

Ordinance - Sec. 16-4. Separation of brush, leaves, yard waste and other compostables or recyclables.

(b) All persons who gather leaves, yard waste, compostables or designated recyclables, shall source separate the items and place them for collection at the times and in the manner heretofore or hereafter specified by this ordinance or the director of public service.

When cleaning out your yards this spring, please remember that all branches need to be under 4 ft. long, bundled and put to the curb on your regular garbage pickup day. The bundle cannot be over 40 pounds in weight.
