


Precincts Affected With City Council District Changes

Warren residents and businesses **ONLY** are invited to a free document shredding day Saturday, July 22 from 9 am – 1 pm at Warren City Hall. **I.D.'s required.**

Please put all boxes or bags of paper in your trunk, remain in your vehicle and a worker will take the boxes/bags. There is no contact.

Examples of items that can be shredded are invoices, bank statements, cancelled checks, tax returns, contracts, personal papers, etc.

We ask that each vehicle have a limit of **5 bags or boxes.** Paper clips, binder clips and staples do not need to be removed.

Cardboard boxes will be collected, and all shredded documents will be recycled. The shredding will be done by Shred Corp. For more information, contact Wendy (586) 574-4509.
