CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Middleswart called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

Additional Invitees & Expenditure for Award Banquet: Commissioner Middleswart relayed the need to vote on the official "Not-To-Exceed" amount for the banquet, with current Purchase Order being written for \$2,000. They also relayed there was an inquiry by the Warren Professional Firefighters Union about their interest in having two or three Executive Board members attend.
