Mayor Stone Announces Waste Water Treatment and Fleet Maintenance Appointments

Mayor Stone has appointed Danuta (Donna) Dordeski as Waste Water Treatment Sanitary Engineer. Donna has worked for the city of Warren for nearly 30 years. Previous positons held include Drafting Specialist, Civil Engineer, Acting City Engineer, and Environmental Compliance Engineer. Donna demonstrates expertise in all aspects of professional civil engineering as it relates to design, development, maintenance, and construction of municipal projects.
