Warren Police Arrest Fatal Hit & Run Suspect – Victim struck at 11 & Hoover Intersection

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an update regarding the arrest of a suspect involved in a fatal hit and run traffic crash which occurred on Saturday (05/04/2024) near the intersection of 11 Mile and Hoover.

On 05/04/2024 at approximately 09:56 pm, Warren Police and Fire Units were dispatched to a suspected hit and run crash involving a pedestrian near 11 Mile and Hoover Rd. Officers arrived on scene and observed a 65-year old male in the roadway suffering from serious life-threatening injuries. The Warren Fire Department quickly transported the victim to an area hospital wherein he was later pronounced deceased by hospital staff. The vehicle which had struck the victim fled the scene prior to officers arrival. A preliminary investigation on scene revealed that the victim was walking northbound on Hoover and was struck by a dark-colored pickup truck. Investigators learned that the pickup truck likely stopped at a nearby business parking lot after the crash. The pickup truck then fled the scene with the driver never reporting the crash. Evidence Technicians and investigators processed the scene and notified the victim's family. The victim was a Warren resident local to the area.

A team of investigators was assigned the case in order to quickly identify the pickup truck and the driver. Using advanced law enforcement technologies and investigative techniques, investigators were able to identify the pickup truck as being a black, 2020 Dodge Ram. On 05/06/2024, investigators found the Dodge Ram parked, unoccupied, at a storage lot in Shelby Township. Investigators located the registered owner of the vehicle and confirmed he was out-of-state during the date/time of the crash. Through other investigative techniques, investigators were able to link a 35-year-old male as being the likely driver of the Dodge Ram during the crash. This suspect showed a residence in Warren in close proximity to the crash scene. On 05/07/2024, investigators made contact with this suspect and placed him under arrest without incident. The suspect later made statements to investigators confirming his involvement in this traffic crash.

The Macomb County Prosecutor's Office charged 35-year-old Savion Jones of Detroit with one count of Failing to Stop at the Scene of a Crash resulting in Death (5-year felony). Today, Jones was arraigned by Judge Chupa at the 37th District Court wherein a not guilty plea was entered. Bond was set at \$200,000 cash/surety only with a GPS tether required if bond is posted. Jones has a previous felony fraud conviction and was charged as a habitual second offender. His next court date is 05/23/2024.
