One Person Deceased in Afternoon Shooting – Incident likely domestic violence related

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an initial update to a shooting which occurred this afternoon (11/04/2024) at a residence in the 24,000 block of Bolam Street (near 10 Mile & Groesbeck). A 29-year-old male was pronounced deceased after being transported to an area hospital. The female suspect was located on scene and taken into custody without incident. There is no apparent danger to the public at this time.

A preliminary investigation into this incident has shown that, on 11/04/2024 at approximately 04:20 pm, Warren Police Units were dispatched to a residence in the 24,000 block of Bolam regarding a shooting. Officers arrived and learned that a male victim had been shot and had fled the scene on foot after the shooting. Officers checked the area and located the victim on a nearby street. The victim suffered a gunshot wound to his chest/abdomen area and was transported to an area hospital by the Warren Fire Department wherein he was later pronounced deceased as a result of his injuries. Other officers made contact with the 33-year-old female resident on scene. The female resident admitted to shooting the male at her residence. The female resident advised that she and the victim have been dating off/on for a while. This afternoon, the male allegedly forced entry into the residence and chased after the female. A shooting then occurred with the male being struck one time. The female was then taken into custody without incident pending further investigation. Investigators have confirmed an extensive domestic-violence history at the residence between the male and the female.

Investigators are confident there is no known danger to the public at this time. Investigators and evidence technicians are continuing to process the scene and will be looking into the circumstances that led up to this deadly incident.
