Male Deceased after Early Morning Shooting – 2 suspects in custody

The Warren Police Department would like to provide a preliminary update regarding a homicide which occurred early this morning. Two adult suspects are currently in custody and there is no threat to the community at this time.

Today (11/08/2024) at approximately 2:12 am, Warren Police Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 11,000 Paige regarding a shooting. Officers along with the Warren Fire Department arrived on scene and located a 23-year-old male with gunshot wounds in the backyard of a residence. Sadly, the victim was pronounced deceased on scene from his injuries. Officers spoke with several persons on scene and learned that this incident may have stemmed from an earlier domestic-violence incident involving the victim, his ex-girlfriend, and possibly some other family members of the ex-girlfriend. Information gathered on scene led officers to a residence in the 11,000 of Jewett Street. Officers arrived at this location to check if any suspects or persons of interest were present. At this location, officers confirmed that multiple unknown persons and young children were inside the residence. The Special Response Team was activated to maximize safety during attempts to make contact with persons inside the residence. Ultimately, two adult females were located inside the residence without incident. These females were then transported to the Warren Police Department for additional questioning. Through additional investigation, investigators learned that an adult male relative of one of the females was likely involved in this shooting. Investigators learned that this 32-year-old male was inside of a residence in the 27,000 of Thomas Street. Officers and members of the Special Response Team responded to this location wherein they were able to take this male into custody without incident. An additional female was also transported to the Warren Police Department for follow up questioning.

There is no active threat to the community at this time as this incident involved persons all known to each other. All persons believed to be involved were taken into custody within 8 hours of this incident first being reported. This is still an open and active investigation with investigators continuing to examine the events that led up to this shooting. Detectives will present the results of their investigation to the Macomb County Prosecutor's Office who will review the matter and determine what criminal charges are appropriate.
