**Don't Wait Any Longer / Home Repair Loans Available**

The City of Warren's Residential Rehabilitation Program is accepting applications from income-eligible households for low or no interest loans. The loans are used to bring the home up to code and make repairs to owner-occupied single-family residences. The maximum loan amount is \$35,000. To qualify for the Program, applicants must **own and occupy** the home, have homeowner's insurance, have a history of making house and property tax payments (including the water bill) on time, and have a household income that is below the limits established by The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

Household Size	Income Limit
1	\$53,700
2	\$61,400
3	\$69,050
4	\$76,700
