The Purchasing Division concurs with the Waste Water Treatment Plant and recommends that the award to provide Mowing Services for the 2025 Season be extended to Premier Group Associates, LC, in an annual amount not to exceed \$77,959.20.

On April 12, 2022, Warren City Council approved an award to Premier Group Associates, 2221 Bellevue Street, Detroit, MI 48207, for providing mowing services for the Waste Water Treatment Plant in a total amount not to exceed \$130,900.40, for a two (2) year period, with options to extend for three (3) additional one-year periods at an annual cost not to exceed \$66,580.40. This recommendation before your honorable body is for the second optional one-year period (the 2025 season) in an annual amount not to exceed \$77,959.20.

The agreement allows the City to remove and add properties at a comparable price. Due to the completion at the Stephens Basin, located at 14210 Stephens Road, the Waste Water Treatment Plant has chosen to revise the mowing zone (12R) for the 2025 season to include the completed site, at a comparable price, in the annual amount of \$7,745.00. Amendment No. 3 to Qualified Plan Account Application and Service Agreement, dated November 19, 2024 ("Amendment No. 3"), between Sigma Planning Corporation, a Michigan corporation located at 300 Parkland Plaza, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48103 ("SPC"), Mark J. Woolhiser, an individual with his registered branch office located at 784 S. Main Street, Plymouth, Michigan 48170 ("IAR"), and the City of Warren, Michigan ("City," and together with SPC and IAR, the "Parties," and each, a "Party").

WHEREAS, the Parties have entered into a Qualified Plan Account Application and Service Agreement, which took effect on February 7, 2018 (the "Existing Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties previously amended the Existing Agreement ("Amendment No. 1") to modify Section 10.2 (Effect and Duration), the Arbitration Clause (page 11), and Appendix C (Flat Fee) of the Existing Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties most recently amended the Existing Agreement on May 31, 2023 ("Amendment No. 2") to memorialize the Parties' mutual consent to renew the Existing Agreement for two years under the provisions of Section 10.2; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to renew the Existing Agreement for two more years under the provisions of Section 10.2 and to adjust the corresponding fees in Appendix C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.3 of the Existing Agreement, the amendments contemplated by the Parties may be contained in a written agreement signed by an authorized representative of each Party.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises set forth above and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Definitions</u>. Capitalized terms used and not defined in this Amendment No. 3 have the respective meanings assigned to them in the Existing Agreement.
- 2. <u>Amendment to the Existing Agreement</u>. As of the Effective Date (defined below), the Existing Agreement is hereby amended or modified as follows:
- (a) Section 10.2 of the Existing Agreement is hereby amended by deleting the second paragraph, which was added through Amendment No. 2, and inserting in its place a new second paragraph that replaces and supersedes its predecessor and reads as follows:

"Sponsor and Investment Advisor previously agreed to exercise the option to renew the Agreement for an additional two-year period running from February 7, 2023 to February 7, 2025. Furthermore, Sponsor and Investment Advisor hereby agree, and have agreed, to exercise the option

to renew the Agreement for another two-year period running from February 7, 2025 to February 7, 2027. Upon the completion of this two-year period, Sponsor and Investment Advisor shall have a final option to renew the Agreement for an additional one-year period, with the mutual consent of the parties."

(b) Appendix C of the Existing Agreement is hereby amended by adding the following text as a new paragraph:

"Notwithstanding the foregoing regarding cost-of-living adjustments, Sponsor and Investment Advisor hereby agree, and have agreed, that the flat annual fees, payable quarterly, in *advance* of the period for which Services are to be rendered by Investment Advisor, shall be as follows during the two-year renewal period commencing on February 7, 2025:

- (i) \$60,100.50 for the one-year period commencing on February 7, 2025 and concluding on February 6, 2026; and
- (ii) \$61,903.52 for the one-year period commencing on February 7, 2026 and concluding on February 6, 2027."
- Date of Effectiveness; Limited Effect. This Amendment No. 3 will become effective on the date first written above (the "Effective Date"). Except as expressly provided in this Amendment No. 3, all of the terms and provisions of the Existing Agreement, Amendment No. 1, and Amendment No. 2 are and will remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed by the Parties. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the amendments contained herein will not be construed as an amendment to or waiver of any other provision of the Existing Agreement, Amendment No. 1, or Amendment No. 2, or as a waiver of or consent to any further or future action on the part of any Party that would require the waiver or consent of the other Parties. On and after the Effective Date, each reference in the Existing Agreement, Amendment No. 1, and Amendment No. 2 to "this Agreement," "the Agreement," "hereunder," "hereof," "herein," or words of like import, and each reference to the Existing Agreement in any other agreements, documents, or instruments executed and delivered pursuant to, or in connection with, the Existing Agreement, will mean and be a reference to the Existing Agreement as amended by this Amendment No. 3.
- 4. <u>Representations and Warranties</u>. Each Party hereby represents and warrants to the other Parties that:
- (a) It has the full right, power, and authority to enter into this Amendment No. 3 and to perform its obligations hereunder and under the Existing Agreement as amended by this Amendment No. 3.
- (b) The execution of this Amendment No. 3 by the individual whose signature is set forth at the end of this Amendment No. 3 on behalf of such Party, and the delivery of this

Amendment No. 3 by such Party, have been duly authorized by all necessary action on the part of such Party.

(c) This Amendment No. 3 has been executed and delivered by such Party and (assuming due authorization, execution, and delivery by the other Parties hereto) constitutes the legal, valid, and binding obligation of such Party, enforceable against such Party in accordance with its terms.

On May 9, 2023 City Council approved an extension of award to ESO Solutions, Inc. for providing Version 3 compliant Incident Reporting Software for the Fire Department for period of five years.

The Fire Department uses the ESO Software to record incidents that the department responds to on an annual basis. The software has the ability to report this information to state and federal agencies, as well as acting as a billing agent for EMS invoicing.

For the period June 4, 2023 through June 3, 2024, EMS incidents have risen from 13,000 to 15,535, total incidents have risen from 19,000 to 20,326, and the number of users has increased from 128 to 138. Since the department pays a unit cost per incident and number of users, there is an increased cost due to the increased activity and the number of user that utilize the software. Thus, the Fire Department is requesting an increase of award in the amount of \$10,278.97.

In addition, the Fire Department is seeking approval to pay the NFIRS and Fire Inspection Software in the annual amount of \$10,206.71 for the period June 26, 2024 through June 25, 2025.

The Fire Department uses ESO software to record our approximately 22,000 incidents the department responds to annually and for reporting to state and federal agencies along with our billing agent for EMS invoicing. In reviewing our contract with ESO I have determined that ESO has the contractual right to annually review our EMS, fire and total incident volumes and number of users to ensure that incidents in the various categories are consisted with actual volumes as outlined in our contract with ESO. In 2023 ESO exercised their option to review our incidents in the various categories and number of users and determined that there were increases in all categories including EMS incidents increasing from the estimated 13,000 EMS incidents to the actual 15,535, total incidents increased from 19,000 to 20,326 total incidents and the number of users increased from 128 to 138. ESO applied these actual totals to our contractually established unit pricing causing our invoice to increase from \$36,580.59 to \$46,859.56 or an increase of \$10,278.97 for the billing period June 4, 2024, to June 3, 2025. Additionally, our NFIRS reporting, and inspection software remained the same at \$10,206.71for the period June 26, 2024, through June 25, 2025. Total cost for both software programs equal \$57,066.27.

Therefore, I am asking to increase our spending authorization by \$10,278.97 to cover the increased annual cost caused by additional users and increasing incident volume in all categories to the new amount of \$46,859.56 for the incident reporting software and \$10,206.71 for the cost of NFIRS and fire inspection software for a total amount of \$57.066.27 for both software products. It should also be noted that I will continue to work with ESO to consolidate both invoices into a single invoice and to update the contract to accurately reflect our current and projected totals through 2028, which is the end of our current contract with ESO

The Police Department desires to increase the authorized spending limit for Canfield Equipment Services Inc. for the upcoming award year beginning on December 6, 2024. The department uses this company to install emergency lighting, radios, antenna, sirens, and related electrical equipment in our emergency patrol vehicles. Currently, Canfield will be awarded no more than \$220,000 from December 6, 2024 through December 5, 2025. As you know, over the course of this year the department's award was raised from the original \$220,000 to \$465,000 due to various needs.

In the upcoming year, the Warren Police Department is projected to purchase fourteen patrol vehicles. An estimated cost for upfitting each of these patrol vehicles is approximately \$24,000 per vehicle (total \$336,000). Also, the Warren Police department has recently ordered/received fifteen other vehicles, which will be utilized for various purposes from traffic to unmarked/investigative. Six of the vehicles are estimated to have minimal upfitting needs of approximately \$1,000 per vehicle (total \$6,000). Nine of the vehicles will need upfitting at an approximate cost of \$17,000 (total \$153,000).

As of now, Canfield will be doing as much of the work on these vehicles as possible before the expiration of this year's contract. Unfortunately, these upfits are labor intensive at approximately two weeks per vehicle, not including the time for parts delivery. Therefore, the Warren Police Department requests to increase the authorized amount awarded to Canfield to \$450,000.
