Rubbish collection will be on time Dec. 30 and Dec. 31, but one day behind Jan. 1 - Jan. 3.



Sanitation Division:

Trash Guidelines & Bulk Items

- 1) Please use 96 gallon blue lid bin that was provided by the City of Warren.
- 2) Bins should be placed wheels next to curb at least 3 feet apart from parked cars, other bins, fences, mailboxes and other obstructions.
- 3) All materials must fit inside bin with the lid closed. Trash should be bagged inside bins. Spillage will occur if trash is loose and/or lid is not closed.
- 4) Household trash should be placed in your blue lid bins. Any bulk items that will not fit in your bin may be placed at the curb on your trash pickup day.
- 5) Please try to limit to one bulk item per week.

- Once in the data base, you can call and set up appointments at least 2 weeks in advance
- Appointments are taken on a first call/first serve basis (with a specific number of appointment slots each day)

- Available for Senior Citizens (60 years & older) or Disabled Adults
 - Warren Residents Only
 - Used for the **SMART** transportation

- Call 586-268-8400 at least 2 days prior to request your tickets and make arrangements to pick them up
 - You will need to show proof of your Warren Residency: picture ID with name & Warren address
- Proof of disability requires a note from Doctor (on their letterhead with Doctors information) dated within the last 30 days.

**Don't Wait Any Longer
Home Repair Loans Available**



The City of Warren's Residential Rehabilitation Program is accepting applications from income-eligible households for low or no interest loans. The loans are used to bring the home up to code and make repairs to owner-occupied single-family residences. The maximum loan amount is \$35,000. To qualify for the Program, applicants must **own** and **occupy** the home, have homeowner's insurance, have a history of making house and property tax payments (including the water bill) on time, and have a household income that is below the limits established by The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):
