## Don't Wait Any Longer Home Repair Loans Available



The City of Warren's Residential Rehabilitation Program is accepting applications from income-eligible households for low or no interest loans. The loans are used to bring the home up to code and make repairs to owner-occupied single-family residences. The maximum loan amount is \$30,000. To qualify for the Program, applicants must **own and occupy** the home, have homeowner's insurance, have a history of making house and property tax payments (including the water bill) on time, and have a household income that is below the limits established by The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

Household Size	Income Limit
1	\$53,700
2	\$61,400
3	\$69,050
4	\$76,700

Warren residents and businesses **ONLY** are invited to a free document shredding day Saturday, July 20 from 9 am – 1 pm at Warren City Hall. **I.D.'s are required.**

Please put all boxes or paper bags in your trunk, remain in your vehicle and a worker will take the boxes/bags. **No plastic bags please.**

Examples of items that can be shredded are invoices, bank statements, cancelled checks, tax returns, contracts, personal papers, etc.

We ask that each vehicle have a **limit of 5 bags or boxes.** Paper clips, binder clips and staples **do not** need to be removed.
