The City of Warren is offering residential repair loans for low to moderate income households (up to 80% of the AMI). Housing Rehabilitation loans are available on a first come, first served basis for single-family homes with a maximum loan amount of \$35,000.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must own & occupy home • Must be current on mortgage and property taxes • Must have homeowner's insurance • Must meet income limits

- Roof • Doors • Electrical • Windows • Plumbing • Heating • Siding • Gutters • Furnace ... etc.
