## Warren Fire Department Response to Commercial Fire

## For Immediate Release:

**Warren, MI – Monday August 25, 2025** – At 4:54 a.m., the Warren Fire Department was dispatched to a reported commercial fire on the 5000 block of Eight Mile Road.

Upon arrival, firefighters discovered a two-story unoccupied commercial building with heavy smoke and flames visible from the second floor. Crews quickly deployed 5-inch supply lines, made entry, and began extinguishing the fire while simultaneously conducting a search for occupants.

The Incident Commander determined that fire conditions being reported by interior crews warranted that fire crews assume a defensive operation and ordered the evacuation of the building along with the three adjacent structures as a precaution. During the search of the uninvoled structures, firefighters located an elderly male residing in the building on the east side of the fire structure. The individual was evacuated from the building and evaluated on scene by fire personnel and released with no reported injuries.

The fire was brought under control by 5:30 a.m. with no injuries reported to civilians and one minor injury to a firefighter. Warren Fire Inspectors responded to the scene, and the cause of the fire remains under investigation.

The Warren Fire Department commends the swift actions of its firefighters in containing the blaze to the building of origin with only water and smoke damage to the adjasnt buildings while also ensuring the safety of nearby residents and businesses.
