Officer-Involved Shooting – Suspects in stolen vehicle taken into custody shortly after incident

Occurred 09/12/2025 at approx. 06:35 pm; 8 Mile & Waltham Ave

The Warren Police Department is providing an initial update regarding an officer-involved shooting which took place this evening (09/12/2025) at approximately 06:35 pm in the area of 8 Mile Road and Waltham Avenue in the City of Warren. All involved suspects are in custody and there is no ongoing threat to the community. No officers were injured during this incident which remains a very open and active investigation.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that Warren Police Officers responded to a report of a stolen GMC Acadia near 8 Mile and Waltham in the City of Warren. Officers located this vehicle backed into the parking lot of an open business. Officers confirmed the GMC was occupied by a driver and three passengers. As officers in full uniform approached to investigate, the GMC attempted to flee. Preliminary information shows that the GMC struck two Warren Patrol cars and allegedly drove towards officers. An officer-involved shooting then occurred. The GMC then fled the scene with Warren Officers in pursuit. The GMC became disabled near 8 Mile Road and Yonka Street (Detroit) at which time Warren Patrol Officers were able to take all four occupants into custody. The injured suspect was transported to an area hospital by the Detroit Fire Department. This suspect is listed in stable condition and remains in police custody. The other three occupants of the GMC did not sustain any injuries and were transported to the Warren Police Department jail for booking and processing. Warren Police Department Investigators and Evidence Technicians responded to both scenes to process evidence and continue the investigation.
