Traffic Crash involving Universal Ambulance

The Warren Police Department would like to provide an initial update regarding a traffic crash at Hoover & 11 mile involving a Universal Ambulance truck that occurred this morning at approximately 0931 hours.

A preliminary investigation shows that a Universal Ambulance was northbound on Hoover approaching the westbound I-696 Service Drive intersection with their emergency equipment activated. They proceeded into the intersection where they were struck by a Jeep Cherokee that had a green light and was heading westbound on the service drive.

The ambulance was struck on the rear passenger side which led to the ambulance rolling over. Thankfully no one was seriously injured. Both Warren Fire and Warren Police responded to the scene.

The ambulance was occupied by 2 medics and a 55-year-old male patient. All three were taken to the hospital by Warren Fire for further evaluation but no serious injuries have been reported. The Jeep Cherokee was driven by a 33-year-old female and her 2-year-old son. They were checked out at scene by the Warren Fire Department but no injuries were reported and neither were taken to the hospital.

The Warren Police Department's Traffic Crash Reconstruction Unit responded to investigate the scene. No determination on which driver was at fault has been made at this time. The Warren Police Department has no further information at this time and is grateful that no one was seriously injured in this accident.
