The **City of Warren Residential Cross-Connection Program** aims to protect our public water distribution system by eliminating potential sources of contamination. This program includes two essential components:

1. A site inspection
2. Testing of backflow prevention assemblies

To complete these inspections, the **City of Warren Water Department**, in coordination with Water Customer Service Crews, will be visiting your neighborhood. All City personnel will be in official **City of Warren vehicles** and will carry **identification badges** at all times.

If any **modifications or testing** of your backflow prevention assemblies are required, you will be notified following the inspection.
