Public's help sought in identifying hit & run vehicle – two teenagers injured during yesterday's crash

The Warren Police Department is asking for the public's help to identify and locate a vehicle involved in a hit and run traffic crash which injured two teenagers in a Warren neighborhood. This incident occurred Wednesday (11/05/2025) at approximately 3:00 pm in the area of Timken Ave and MacArthur Blvd.

On Wednesday (11/05/2025) at approximately 3:00pm, Warren Police and Fire units responded to hit and run traffic crash involving two teenagers on a bicycle near Timken and MacArthur. Upon arrival, officers confirmed that two teenage brothers riding a bicycle were struck by a dark-colored Chevy Equinox at the intersection of Timken and MacArthur. Witnesses on scene reported that the driver of the Chevy initially stopped to check on the teenage victims but then quickly fled the scene upon hearing emergency sirens/vehicles approach. Both victims sustained minor injuries and were transported by the Warren Fire Department to a nearby hospital. Both juveniles have since been released from the hospital.

Investigators are continuing to investigate this incident by speaking to several witnesses and reviewing video footage from the area. Investigators believe the vehicle involved in this incident is dark-colored Chevy Equinox (see pictures) SUV. Witnesses and the victims reported that the vehicle was driven by a light-skinned Black female with green hair, who was the sole occupant of the Chevy.
