



HALMICH PARK:

North: \$500 all day rental + \$500 deposit
If the park general rules, regulations, and city ordinances are abided by, the deposit will be returned to the permit holder.
Deposits must be made by cash or check.

ALL OTHER PARKS:

Monday-Thursday: Residents \$100, nonresidents \$125
Friday-Sunday: Residents \$120, nonresidents \$150
6 hour rental (Pavilion rentals are booked between 10a-8pm)
Parks available for rent: Austin Dennis, Busse, Butcher, Halmich South, Hartsig, Licht, Miller, Shaw, Veterans South

- Full payment for rental is due at the time of booking
- No inflatables, trains, dunk tanks, petting zoo, or pony rides are permitted.
- A full list of rules will be provided upon payment for the booking.

- Residents may book reservations starting Monday February 2, 2026.
- Nonresidents may book reservations starting Monday March 2, 2026.

WARREN HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Deferred 0% Interest Loans for Owner Occupied, Single-Family Homes

The City of Warren is offering residential repair loans for low to moderate households (up to 80% of the AMI). Housing rehabilitation loans are available on a first-come, first-served basis for single-family homes with a maximum loan amount of \$35,000.

Eligibility requirements: Must own and occupy home Must be current on mortgage and property taxes Must have home owners insurance Must meet income limits

Snow Removal Policy

Warren city ordinances require that all property owners remove snow from their sidewalks 12 hours after the snow stops. This applies to all property owners, residential, commercial and industrial.

Where there is no sidewalk, the occupant or owner shall clear a path free from snow and ice where sidewalks would otherwise be to facilitate pedestrian use.
