SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

Warren city ordinances require that all property owners remove snow from their sidewalks 12 hours after the snow stops. This applies to all property owners, residential, commercial and industrial. Where there is no sidewalk, the occupant or owner shall clear a path free from snow and ice where sidewalks would otherwise be to facilitate pedestrian use.

SNOW EMERGENCY

A snow emergency is declared when 4" or more of snow accumulates. Warren DPW prioritizes main roads, secondary roads, and emergency routes during snowstorms. Snow emergencies coincide with side streets being plowed after more than 4 inches of snow has accumulated, beginning with routes that align with city operations such as next-day trash pickup. Residents must move their vehicles off residential streets to allow city snowplows to clear them. This is mandated and will be enforced by the Warren Police Department. Once your street has been plowed, you may park your vehicles on the street as necessary.



WarrenCAN Community Alert Network

The City of Warren has an emergency alert system. The alert system allows the City of Warren to issue urgent notifications, emergency instructions, warnings, and routine communications to subscribed citizens. These messages may be delivered via email, text message, and voicemail alerts to keep citizens safe and informed. In the event of a local emergency, citizens subscribed to CivicReady will benefit from immediate, actionable information and instructions sent via their preferred notification channel. WARREN HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Deferred 0% Interest Loans for Owner Occupied, Single-Family Homes

The City of Warren is offering residential repair loans for low to moderate households (up to 80% of the AMI). Housing rehabilitation loans are available on a first-come, first-served basis for single-family homes with a maximum loan amount of \$35,000.
