We're replacing over eight miles of natural gas pipeline in Royal Oak, Madison Heights, Clawson and Warren through 2029. Project map on back.

Delivering Natural Gas Value

We're modernizing our natural gas system to improve safety and reliability for customers by replacing eight miles of distribution pipeline in Oakland and Macomb counties.

The four-year project will replace 24-inch steel pipeline dating back to the 1950s that helps us move natural gas quickly, safely and efficiently to over 800,000 homes and businesses in Southeast Michigan. Pre-construction activities will take place in 2025.

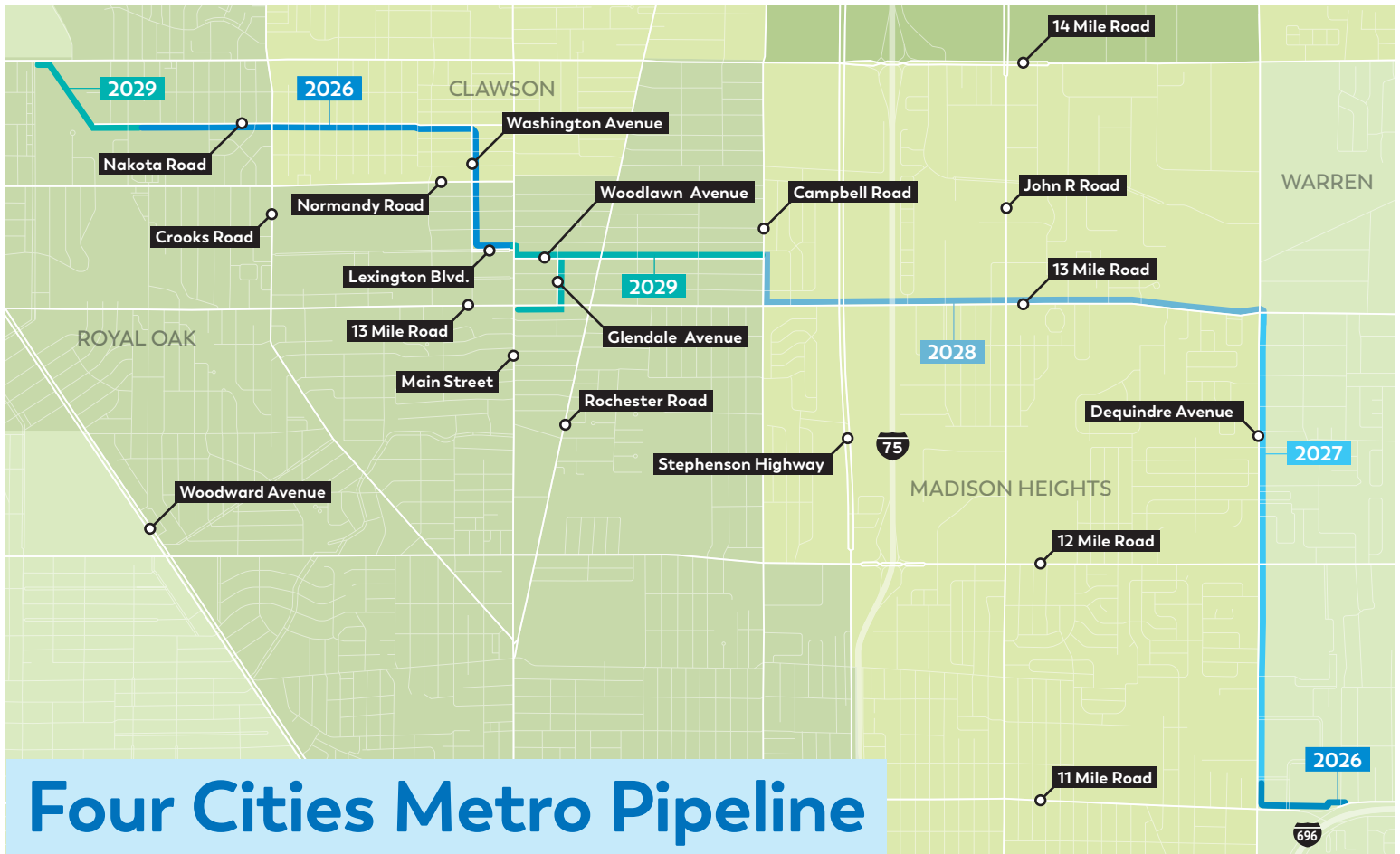
Construction of approximately 2-mile segments will start in 2026 and will continue in the region until 2029. Construction will begin each year in the spring and end in time for the winter heating season.

Customer Benefits
