 - A. State Rep Mike McFall – Discussed William Syndrome and legislation regarding people with PTSD and microdosing psilocybin. This also included a move to decriminalize psilocybin. Also introduced legislation to change the requirement for veterans to receive a disabled veteran license plate. The requirement now is 50% disabled.
 - B. John Petrous – Tappy Guide. Tappy Guide was established in Detroit last year. They have received a second grant and funding from GM and are expanding to Macomb County. Mobile app provides enhanced wayfinding (best/safest routes for travel). It uses AI to provide safety from weather and traffic. The app is free, and the call center is live from 11 am to 7 pm. Call center hours will increase as membership grows.
