### **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

**Warren, MI** — On Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at approximately 8:00 p.m., the Warren Fire Department responded to a reported residential fire in the 7000 block of Republic.

Upon arrival, firefighters observed smoke coming from the second story of a two-story single-family residence. Crews made immediate entry to conduct a search for occupants.

During the search, firefighters located an approximately 50-year-old male in an upstairs bedroom. A thorough search of the residence confirmed that no other individuals were inside.

The male victim was pronounced deceased at the scene. Two cats were also located deceased within the home.

Fire crews quickly extinguished the fire, which was contained to the room of origin.

Warren Police and Fire Investigators responded to the scene to begin an investigation. The Macomb County Medical Examiner's Office has taken jurisdiction and will determine the official cause of death.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation. Fire investigators are scheduled to return to the scene to continue their work.

**The investigation remains ongoing. No further information is available at this time.**
