Two Injured in Warren Motel Fire

Warren, MI — At approximately 11:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 22, 2026, the Warren Fire Department responded to a fire at a two-story motel in the 23000 block of Dequindre Road near Nine Mile Road.

Warren police officers arrived first and attempted to enter a first-floor room but were forced back by heavy smoke and fire conditions.

Fire crews arrived moments later, made immediate entry and located an adult male inside the room. Firefighters removed him from the building while simultaneously bringing the fire under control. Firefighter-paramedics immediately began treating him before transporting him to an area hospital, where he was listed in critical condition.

A second individual, an adult female, was located outside the building with injuries sustained after jumping from a second-floor walkway. She was transported to an area hospital with injuries that were not considered life-threatening.

The fire was contained to the room where it originated.

Investigators from the Warren Police and Fire departments responded to determine the origin and cause of the fire. The cause remains under investigation. At this time, the fire does not appear to be suspicious.

No additional information about the individuals involved is being released at this time.
